Fees for Small Molecule Screens

Each 384-well plate contains about 300 compounds. The remaining wells are empty and can be used for positive and negative controls. For each 384-well plate that is screened, we charge charge 50,- € based on the following calculation

(Sept 2016: ca. 180 Compound plates)

- 30 € for compounds (10 Cent per compound)

- 8 ${\ensuremath{\varepsilon}}$ for DMSO to rinse and clean the needles used for compound transfer

- 7 € for consumables: sealing foils, tips, plastic troughs, Eppendorf tubes, multidrop-cassette etc.

-5 € user fee

If you do not screen the complete collection, we charge a fee of 700.- € for setting up your screen. This fee includes assay establishment, automation on the robot, and a pilot screen of ten compound plates. This fee does not apply if you screen the complete collection or more than 25plates.
